



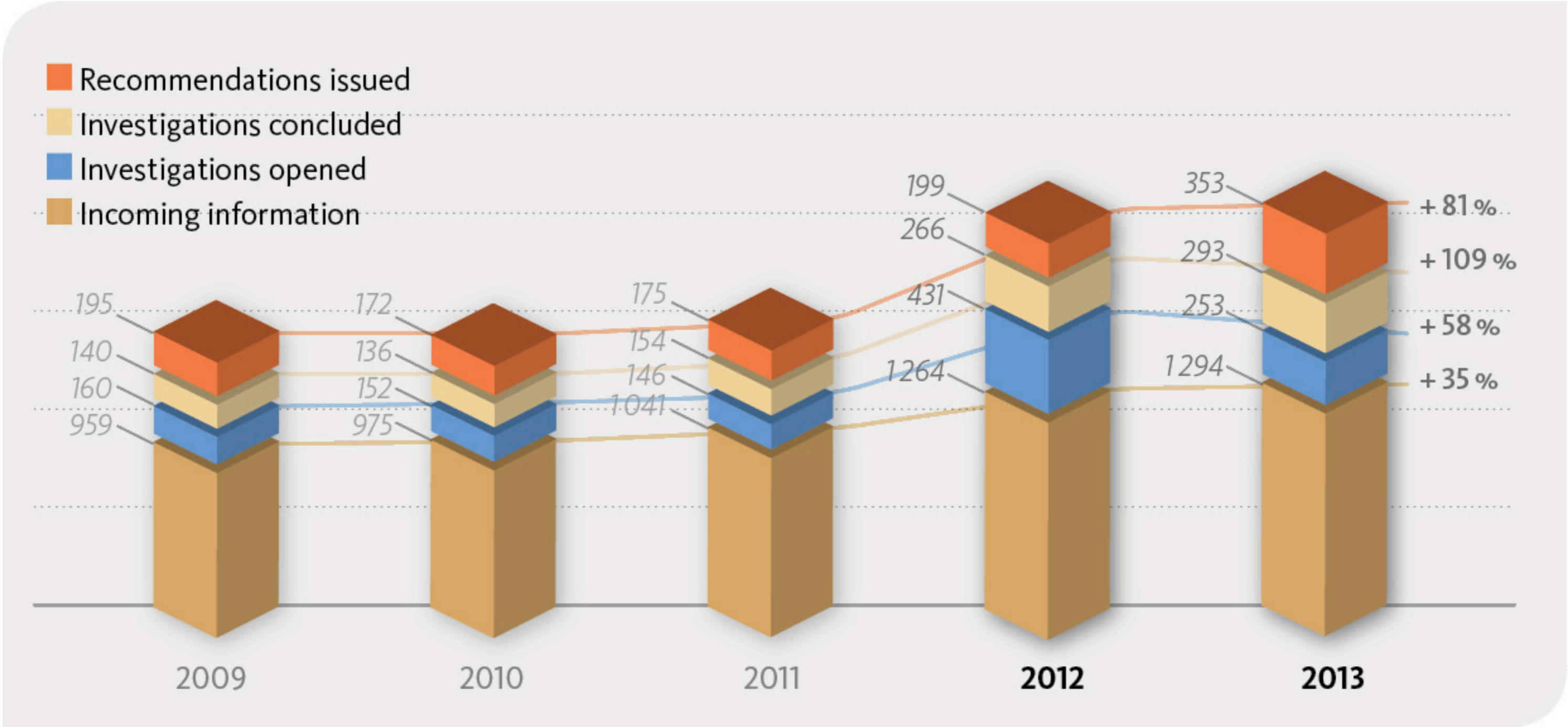

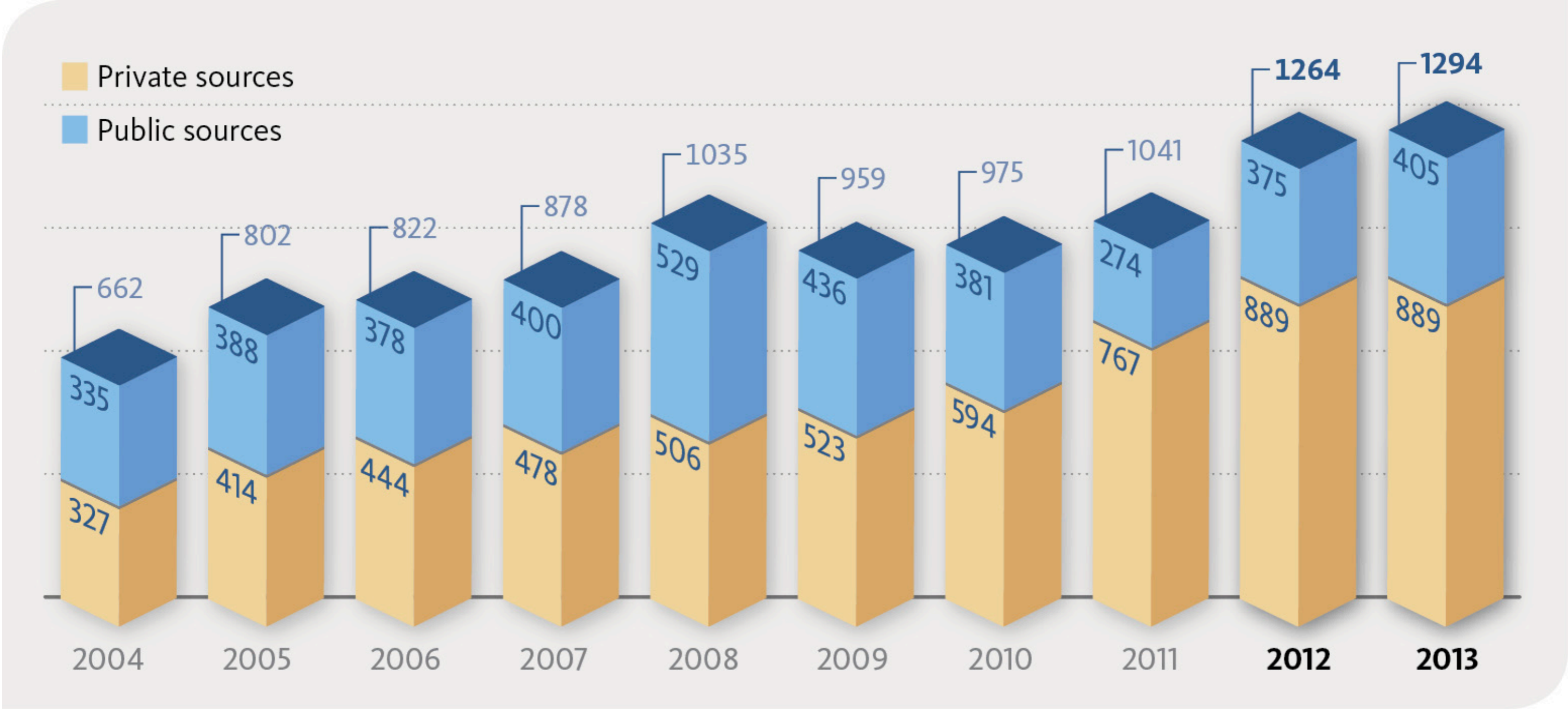

Information sent to OLAF in 2013

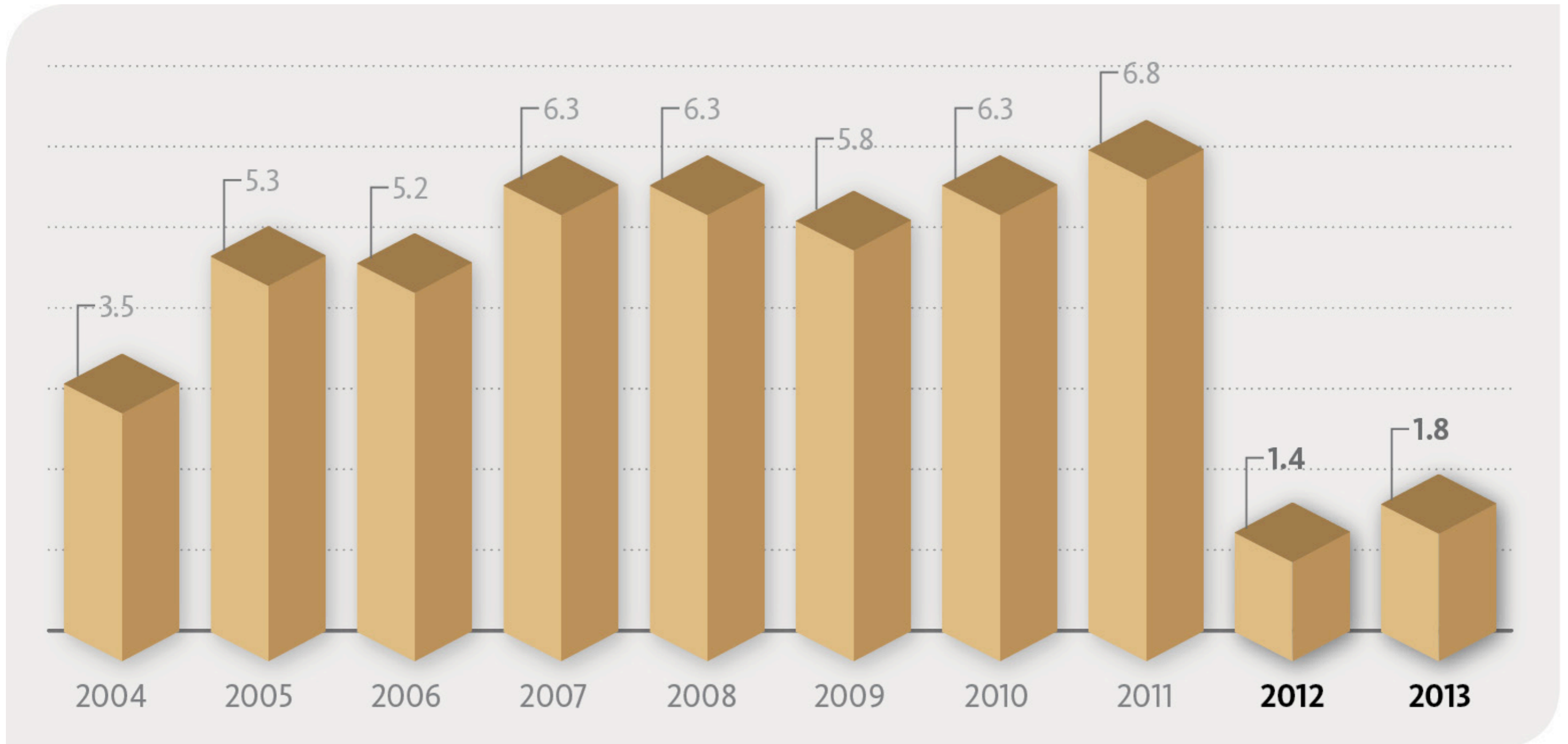
All-time record since the creation of OLAF shows increased trust.

A quicker and more thorough decision on opening a case ("selection phase")

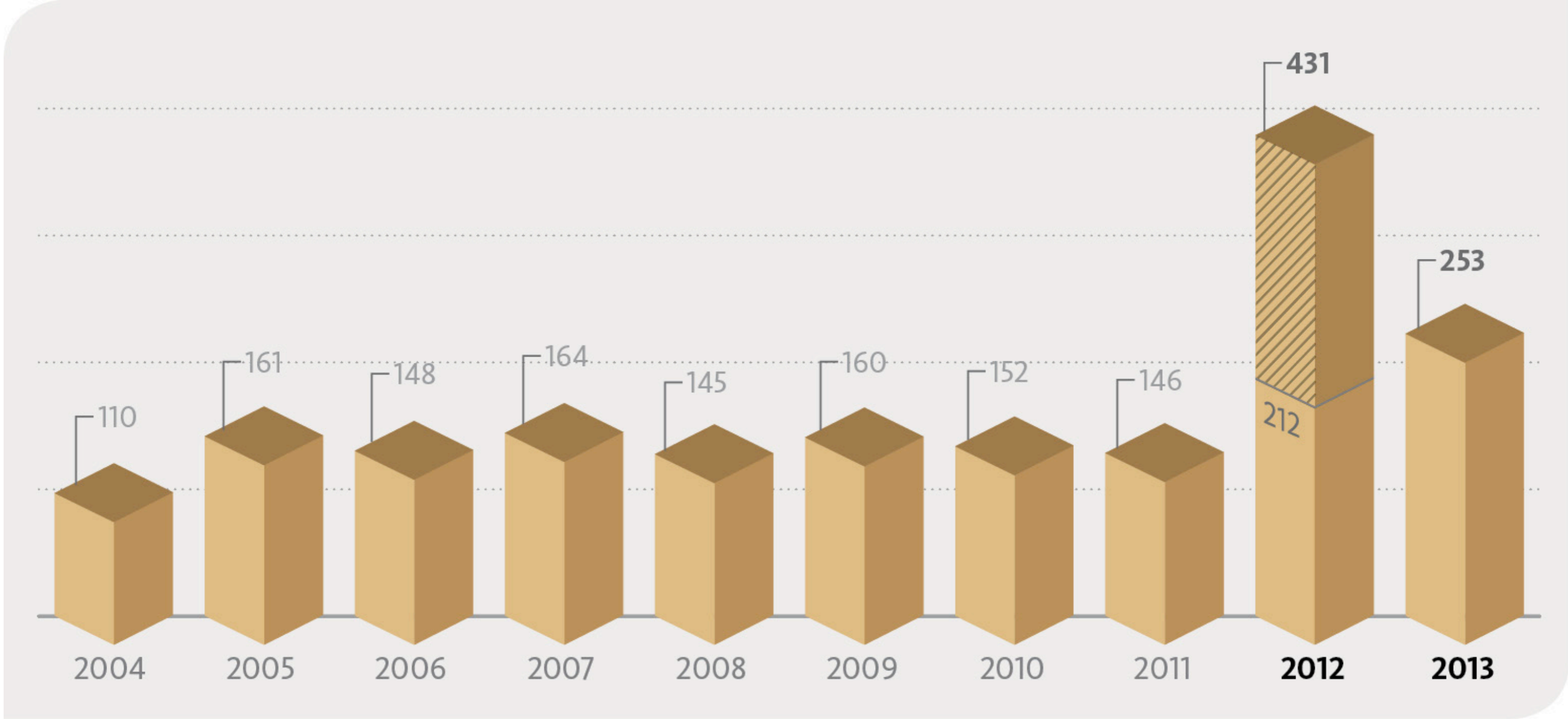
Average duration of case selection phase in months:



The average for 2012 was calculated for 11 months, following the reorganisation of 01.02.2012

OLAF investigations: all-time high in 2012 and 2013, coupled with a decrease in the duration of cases

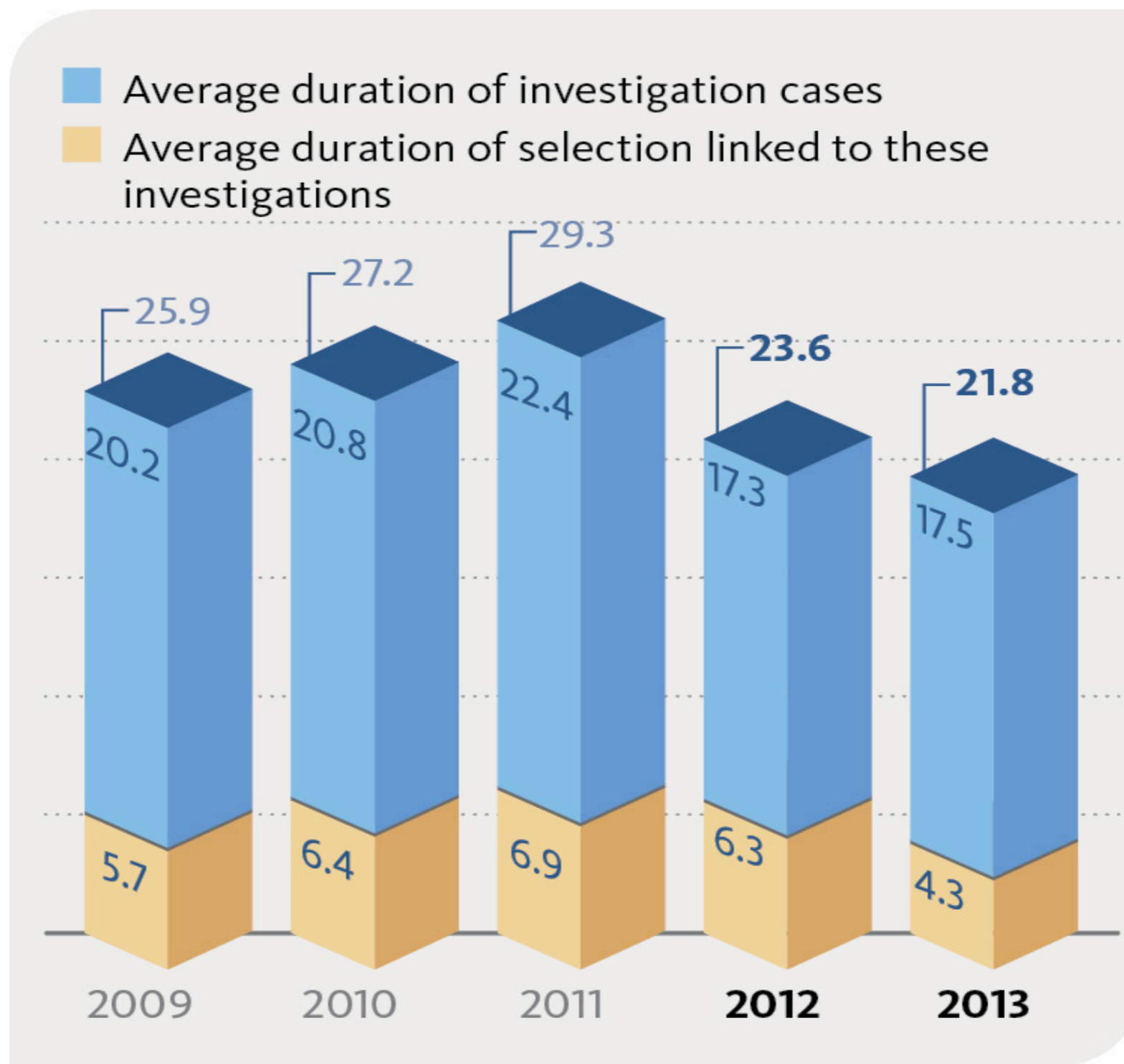
Investigation cases opened by OLAF:



The figures for 2012 include 219 investigation cases, already previously under evaluation and opened as a result of the reorganisation of 01.02.2012

Average duration of OLAF investigation cases (including respective selection phase) in months:

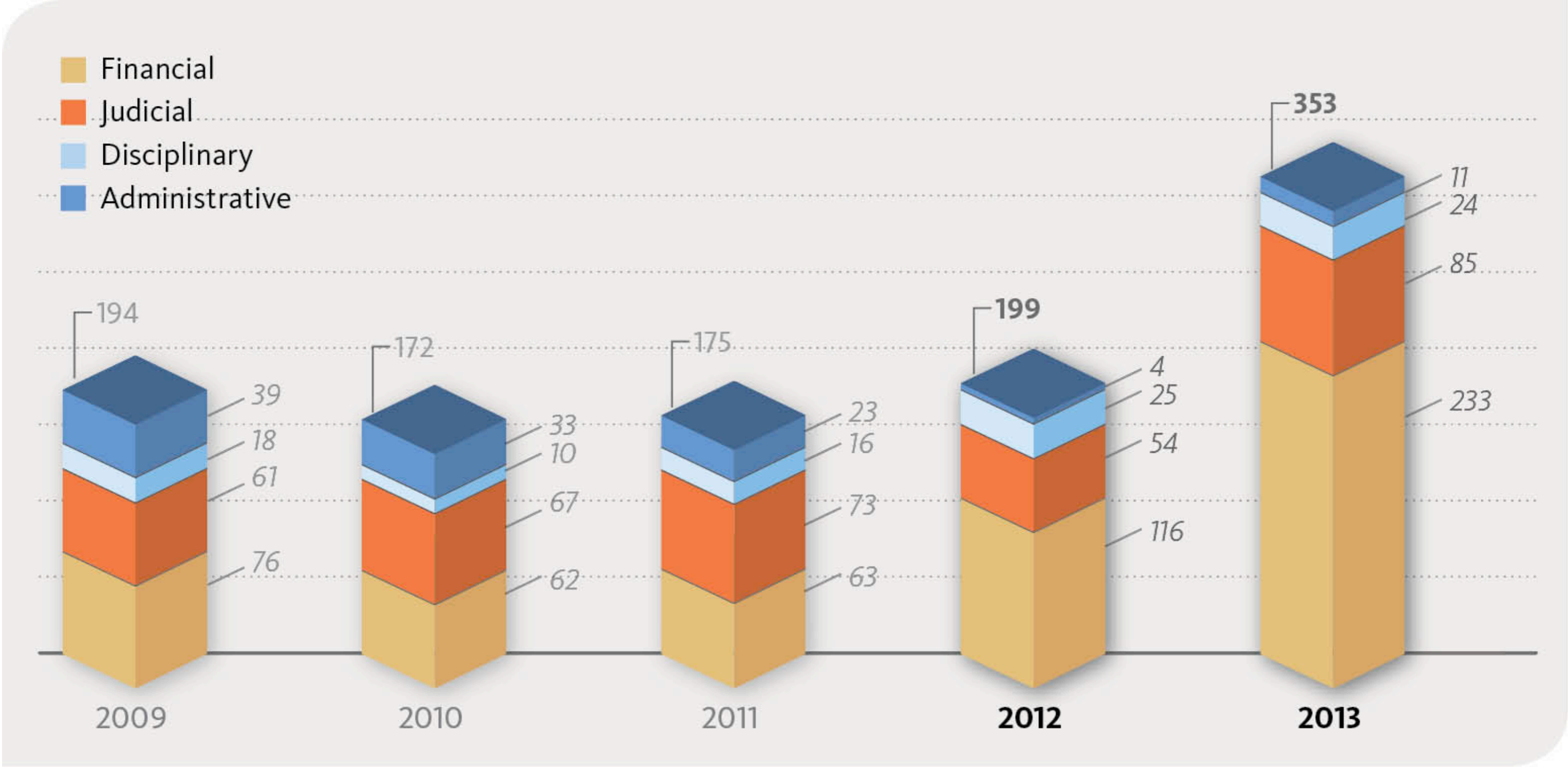


The figures include the average duration of investigation cases closed in 2013 or still open at the end of 2013, as well as the duration of the selection phase corresponding to these investigation cases. Most of these cases were selected before 2013. This is why the duration of their selection phase (4.3 months) differs from the duration of the selections conducted in 2013 (1.8 months).
