While implementing Clause 48 of the National Anti-Corruption Programme of the Republic of Lithuania for 2015–2025, approved by resolution No XII-1537 of the Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania of 10 March 2015 ‘On the Approval of the National Anti-Corruption Programme of the Republic of Lithuania for 2015–2025’, the Government of the Republic of Lithuania resolves:

1. To approve the Interinstitutional Action Plan for 2020–2022 for the Implementation of the National Anti-Corruption Programme of the Republic of Lithuania for 2015–2025 (attached).

To propose to the state and municipal institutions not subordinate to the Government of the Republic of Lithuania to participate in the implementation of the inter-institutional action plan for 2020–2022 for the implementation of the National Anti-Corruption Programme of the Republic of Lithuania for 2015–2025 approved by this resolution.

**CHAPTER I
GENERAL PROVISIONS**

1. The Interinstitutional Action Plan for 2020–2022 (hereinafter – the Plan) for the Implementation of the National Anti-Corruption Programme of the Republic of Lithuania for 2015–2025 developed in accordance with the National Anti-Corruption Programme of the Republic of Lithuania for 2015–2025, approved by resolution No XII-1537 of the Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania of 10 March 2015 ‘On the Approval of the National Anti-Corruption Programme of the Republic of Lithuania for 2015–2025’ (hereinafter – the Programme).

2. The development of the plan was determined by the necessity to ensure the continuity of the anti-corruption activities, long-term, efficient and targeted operation of the corruption prevention and control system in the Republic of Lithuania.

3. Purpose of the Plan:

3.1. Ensure coordinated, smooth and efficient implementation of the Programme, to maintain its continuity and reach substantial progress in the priority areas specified in Clause 7 of the Programme: political activity and legislation; activities of courts and law enforcement agencies; public procurement; health care and social security; territorial planning, state construction supervision and waste management; supervision of the activities of economic operators; public administration, civil service and asset management; private sector.

3.2. Ensure that the strategic objective of the Program is achieved – the Lithuanian Corruption Perceptions Index in 2025 would be at least 70 points.

3.3. Consistently and effectively improve the corruption prevention and control system, anti-corruption education and awareness, ensure the continuity of prevention and control measures – make a positive impact on areas of public life and increase transparency in the state.

4. The implementation of the objectives and tasks of the Programme will also be influenced by:

4.1. The project ‘Improvement of the Business Supervision System’ (project code 10.1.4-ESFA-V-921-02-0001) is being implemented by the Ministry of Economy and Innovation.

4.2. The measures specified in the Interinstitutional Action Plan for the Implementation of the Information Society Development Programme ‘Lithuanian Digital Agenda’ for 2014–2020, approved by resolution No 478 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania of 27 April 2015 ‘On the Approval of the Interinstitutional Action Plan for the Implementation of the Information Society Development Programme ‘Lithuanian Digital Agenda’ for 2014–2020’, related to enabling

economic operators to use information processed by state institutions and to encourage them to develop new electronic products and services ('Develop open data solutions enabling businesses and the public easier access and use of data processed by public sector institutions').

5. The implementation of the Plan is monitored, controlled and coordinated by the Commission of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania to coordinate the fight against corruption.

6. The Plan is implemented from the general appropriations approved in the state budget of the Republic of Lithuania for the executors responsible for the implementation of the measures of the Plan (the measures of the Plan for which implementation no funds are provided will be implemented using the internal resources and general appropriations of the responsible executors) and other funds received in accordance with the procedure established by legislation. The executors of the measures responsible for the implementation of the Programme will be responsible for the planning of the necessary financial resources according to the competence.

7. The results of the Plan are monitored by the Special Investigation Service.

8. Executors of the Plan within 25 calendar days from the end of each quarter in the monitoring information system and executors who are not accountable to the Government of the Republic of Lithuania and do not have access to the monitoring information system shall provide the Special Investigation Service in writing with information on the progress and results of the implementation of the Plan having regard to the approved objectives, tasks, measures of the Plan and the appropriations provided for their implementation, as well as the assessment criteria and their values. Information on the assessment criteria that cannot be calculated on a quarterly basis is provided taking into consideration the terms of obtaining the data.
