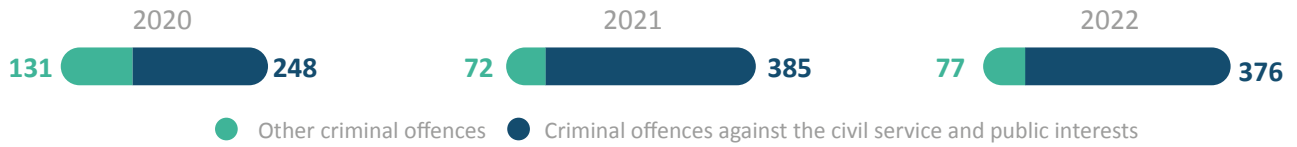

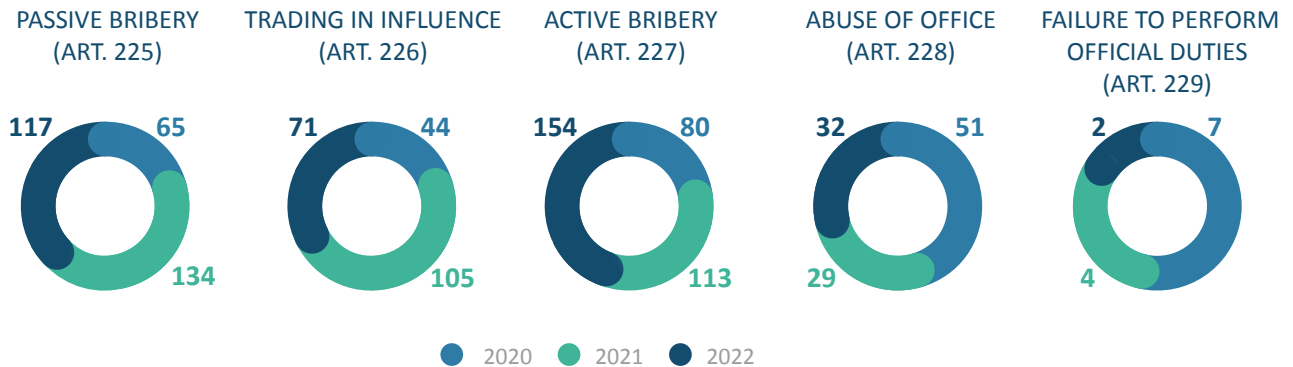

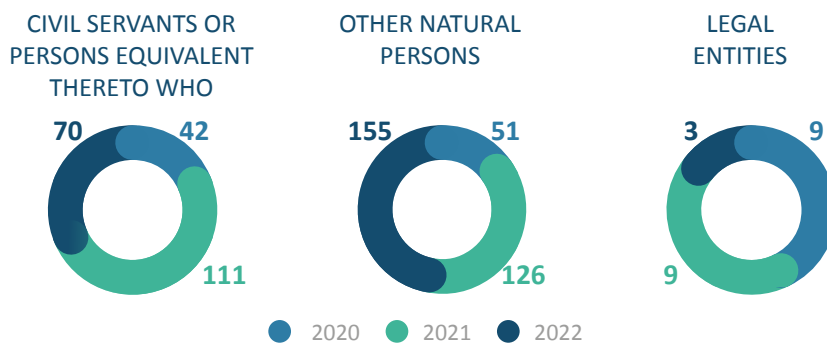
CHANGES IN THE NUMBER OF DETECTED CRIMINAL OFFENCES (BY CATEGORIES)



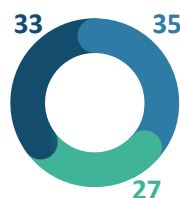
CHANGES IN THE NUMBER OF DETECTED CRIMINAL OFFENCES (BY ARTICLES OF THE CRIMINAL CODE)



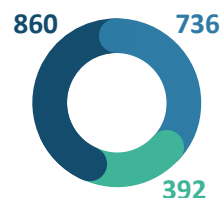
CHANGES IN THE NUMBER OF SUSPECTS

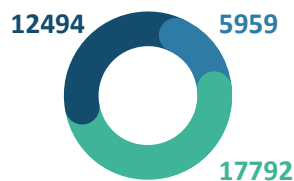
